Code of Conduct for Club Volunteers

Obligations towards the Game

- Set a positive example for others, particularly young players and supporters
- Promote and develop their own team having regard to the interest of the Players, Supporters and reputation of the national game
- Share knowledge and experience when invited to do so, taking into account the interest of the body that has requested this rather than personal interests
- Avoid all forms of gamesmanship.
- Show due respect to Match Officials and others involved in the game.
- Always have regard for the best interests of the game, including where publicly expressing an opinion of the game and any particular aspect of it, including others involved in the game.
- Not use or tolerate inappropriate language.

Obligation toward the team

- Give priority to the team over individual interests.
- Resist all illegal or unsporting influences, including banned substances and techniques.
- Promote ethical principles.
- Show due respect for the interests of the players, coaches and officials, their own club and others.

Obligation towards the supporters

• Show due respect for the interests of supporters

Respect towards Match Officials

- Accept the decisions of Match Officials without protest.
- Avoid words or actions that may mislead a Match Official.
- Show due respect towards Match Officials.

General Obligations

- Adhere to the terms of the Club's policy on Anti-Discrimination
- Adhere to any rules, policies or regulations put in place by the Club.
- Adhere to any rules, policies or regulations put in place by the lease holder/owner at Marine Drive
- If any volunteer is working in the café all regulations/policies that adhere to working with food and hygiene must be followed including the up to date completion of any records. A log will be provided for the completion of records and any other findings that may require to be logged.
